Q-1. Which services are subject to PSA/PLA or Prevailing Wage? Are set-up crews for the trailers subject to PSA/PLA or Prevailing Wage?

A-1. The following services listed in the RFP are subject to the Community Workforce Agreement (CWA):

Temporary Fencing

Temporary Power

The remaining services in the RFP (including set up crews for temporary construction trailers) are not subject to the CWA or prevailing wage.

A-2. No, restrooms and water are not needed for the temporary trailers.

Q-3. Do the temporary trailers need data and power?

A-3. Yes, the temporary trailers will need data & power. Please note that our District is also set-up for WIFI.

Q-4. Will the temporary fencing need sandbags?

A-4. Yes.

Q-5. How much power will be needed at each site?

A-5. 200 amps coming into each site.


Q-6. Is there a specific or preferred time for Lavatory services on Monday and Thursday?
